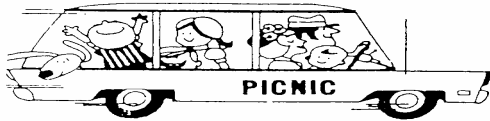

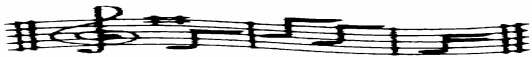
Sign-up sheets are in Herrmann Hall. The shelter is always at its fullest during the summer months. Whatever help you can give is greatly appreciated.
