### **A Word from Fr. Jim**

Today our parish celebrates the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Eucharistic Adoration. It is appropriate that this celebration takes place in the midst of the Easter season for the Eucharist is truly one of the Easter sacraments. It is one of the deepest ways that we continue to experience Christ's ongoing presence with us throughout our lives. As you read through the marvelous resurrection accounts in the scriptures, many of them have Eucharistic overtones to them, and it was in the Breaking of the Bread that the disciples experienced the risen Lord in their midst.
