SPY THOUGHT: Hello, helloooo, can you hear me? Hello God, are you even there???? Why don’t you listen, why don’t you answer mee???? Have you ever wondered why He does not respond or why your prayers were not answered? Actually, many of the Saints felt the same way, especially Mother Teresa. She once confessed she endured years of darkness and suffering and that her cheerfulness was just a cover. When we lift up our voices to God, especially in prayers of petition, we cannot limit God’s response. We must be open to God’s will, especially if it is not easy for us. Sometimes we just need to understand the mystery of God’s will in the details of your life. In some cases God’s revelation is undecipherable, unacceptable, painful, or just not what we want to hear. When we pray to God we should lift up our voices together in the prayer of the faithful and ask God to reveal the mystery of His will in our world and in our life, and then pray that we may accept His will, whatever that may be. Don’t limit God’s response to your prayers by stipulations and expectations. Be open to the mystery of God’s will in your life and only then can we be assured that He will answer all of our prayers in ways far greater than we could ever have imagined.
